BASIC AUDIT REPORT

We have completed certain procedures in accordance with Ohio Rev. Code Section 117.01(G) to the accounting records and related documents of the Oakdale Joint Union Cemetery District, Ashtabula County, (the Cemetery) for the years ended December 31, 2023, and 2022.

Our procedures were designed solely to satisfy the audit requirements of Ohio Rev. Code Section 117.11(A). Because our procedures were not designed to opine on the Cemetery's financial statements, we did not follow *generally accepted auditing standards*. We do not provide any assurance on the Cemetery's financial statements, transactions or balances for the years ended December 31, 2023, and 2022.

The Cemetery's management is responsible for preparing and maintaining its accounting records and related documents. Our responsibility under Ohio Rev. Code Section 117.11(A) is to examine, analyze and inspect these records and documents.

Based on the results of our procedures, we found the following significant accounting issue to report.

Current Year Observation

We noted three payroll checks in 2023 for a full-time employee who earned overtime, however, the time card was not approved by two trustees as indicated by the policy manual. Additionally, we noted one payroll check in 2023 for a part-time employee who worked full time status for one pay and received overtime pay.
