BASIC AUDIT REPORT

Central College Community Development Authority Franklin County 111 North Front Street Columbus, Ohio 43215

We have completed certain procedures in accordance with Ohio Rev. Code § 117.01(G) to the accounting records and related documents of the Central College Community Development Authority, Franklin County, (the Authority) for the years ended December 31, 2024, and 2023.

Our procedures were designed solely to satisfy the audit requirements of Ohio Rev. Code § 117.11(A). Because our procedures were not designed to opine on the Authority's financial statements, we did not follow *generally accepted auditing standards*. We do not provide any assurance on the Authority's financial statements, transactions or balances for the years ended December 31, 2024, and 2023.

The Authority's management is responsible for preparing and maintaining its accounting records and related documents. Our responsibility under Ohio Rev. Code § 117.11(A) is to examine, analyze and inspect these records and documents.

Based on the results of our procedures, we found the following significant compliance or accounting issue to report.

Current Year Observation

We noted as of December 31, 2024, the Authority had two Citizen Member vacancies on the Board. Section 2.5 of the Bylaws of the Board of Trustees of the Central College Community Development Authority (the Bylaws) provides that a vacancy upon the Board shall be deemed to exist upon the death, incapacity, resignation, removal or expiration of terms of office of any of the Trustees. Furthermore, the Columbus City Council may appoint a successor Trustee for the remainder of an unexpired term to fill a vacancy for any of the Citizen Members or the Local Government Member. Lastly, Section 2.3 of the Bylaws and Ohio Rev. Code § 349.04 provide that all appointed Trustees shall be replaced by elected Trustees. We recommend the City of Columbus appoint successor Trustees for the remainder of the unexpired terms, after which those positions are filled by elected Trustees.
