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## Report of Independent Accountants on Agreed-Upon Procedures

To the Executive Committee:

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by the Executive Committee, solely to comply with the requirements of Ohio Rev. Code Section 3517.17. This engagement to apply agreed-upon procedures was performed in accordance with standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The sufficiency of the procedures is solely the responsibility of the specified users of the report. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

The procedures and associated findings are as follows:

### Cash Receipts

We confirmed the Ohio Political Party Fund receipts with the State of Ohio and agreed them to amounts shown on the Ohio Political Party Public Funds Report.

As a result of our procedures, we noted a receipt for \$187.98 from July 13, 1999 was deposited in error to the General Fund account instead of the Public Funds account.

On February 4, 2000, the Republican Executive Committee General Fund account reimbursed the Coshocton County Republican Party Executive Committee Public Funds account \$187.98 to correct this error.

We found no additional exceptions as a result of our procedures.

### Cash Reconciliation

We compared the cash balance recorded on the Ohio Political Party Public Funds Report with the bank balance for the Coshocton County Republican Party Executive Committee Public Funds account as of December 31, 1999.

There were no reconciling items at December 31, 1999.

We found no exceptions as a result of these procedures.

### Cash Disbursements

The Republican Party Executive Committee had no cash disbursements during 1999.

The Republican Party Executive Committee had no payroll cash disbursements during 1999.
