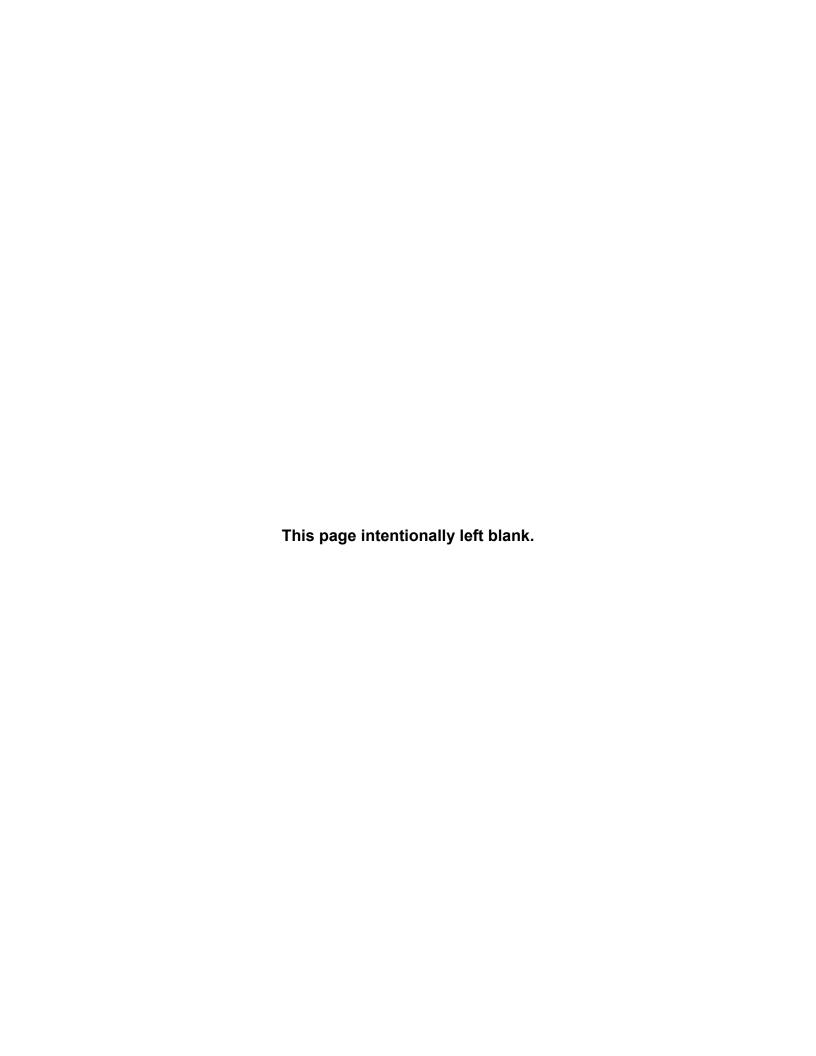

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INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS' REPORT ON APPLYING AGREED-UPON PROCEDURES

To the Executive Committee:

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by the Democratic Party Executive Committee, Hocking County, Ohio (the Committee), solely to assist the Committee in evaluating its compliance with Sections 3517.17 and 3517.18 of the Ohio Revised Code for the year ended December 31, 2002. Management is responsible for the Committee's compliance with those requirements. We followed the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants' attestation standards for agreed-upon procedures engagements. The sufficiency of the procedures is solely the responsibility of the Committee. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

Cash Receipts

We confirmed the Ohio Political Party Fund receipts with the State of Ohio and agreed them to amounts shown on the Political Party Public Funds Report. We found no exceptions.

Cash Reconciliation

- 1. We compared the sum of the cash balances recorded on the Committee's Political Party Public Funds Report with the cash balances reconciled by Doree Ireton, Treasurer, for the Committee as of December 31, 2002. The sums agreed.
- 2. We recomputed the mathematical accuracy of the reconciliation. We found no computational errors.
- We agreed bank balances on the reconciliation with month end bank statements. The balances 3. agreed.
- There were no reconciling items appearing on the December 31, 2002 reconciliation.

Cash Disbursements

- 1. We footed the cash disbursement listing and compared the listing totals to the disbursement totals on the Committee's Political Party Public Funds Report. The amounts agreed.
- 2. We traced the disbursement transaction to the source documentation, such as an invoice and canceled check. We agreed the payee on the check to the name on the invoice. The payee and amount recorded in the Political Party Public Funds Report agreed to the payee and amount on the canceled check.

Cash Disbursements (Continued)

- 3. We compared the signature on the check to the list dated of authorized signatories the Committee provided to us. We compared the endorsement to the payee listed on the check. The signatory on the check was an approved signatory.
- 4. We compared the purpose for the disbursement with the allowable uses described in Section 3517.18 of the Ohio Revised Code. We found no exceptions.

We were not engaged to, and did not perform an examination, the objective of which would be the expression of an opinion on compliance of the Political Party Public Funds Report, which is attached to this report. Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion. Had we performed additional procedures, other matters might have come to our attention that we would have reported to you.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Committee and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone else.
