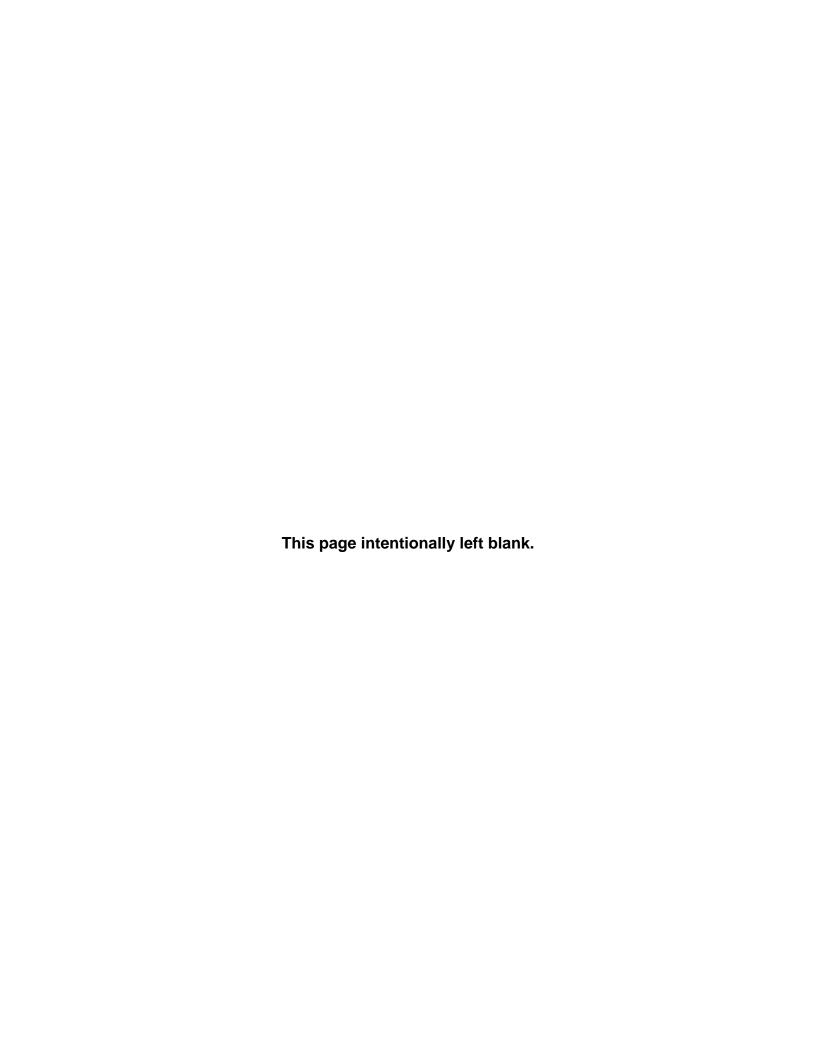

INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS' REPORT ON APPLYING AGREED-UPON PROCEDURES

Republican Party Executive Committee Jackson County 136 Maple Avenue Jackson, Ohio 45640

To the Executive Committee:

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by the Republican Party Executive Committee, Jackson County, Ohio (the Committee), solely to assist the Committee in evaluating its compliance with Sections 3517.17 and 3517.18 of the Ohio Revised Code for the year ended December 31, 2004. Management is responsible for the Committee's compliance with those requirements. We followed the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants' attestation standards for agreed-upon procedures engagements. The sufficiency of the procedures is solely the responsibility of the Committee. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

Cash Receipts

We confirmed the Ohio Political Party Fund receipts with the State of Ohio and agreed them to amounts shown on the Political Party Public Funds Report. However, the Treasurer did not deposit two checks from the State of Ohio, totaling \$56.54 and these warrants went void. We recommend the Treasurer contact the State Department of Taxation to have the warrants reissued.

Cash Reconciliation

The Committee does not have a bank account.

Cash Disbursements

- 1. We footed the Statement of Expenditures and compared the listing totals to the disbursement totals on the Political Party Public Funds Report. The amounts agreed.
- 2. We compared the purpose for the disbursement with the allowable uses described in Section 3517.18 of the Ohio Revised Code. We found no exceptions.
- 3. The recorded disbursements were limited to contributions to the Ohio Republican Party. We confirmed the amount of disbursement totals on the Political Party Public Funds Report with the Ohio Republican Party. We found no exceptions.

Payroll Disbursements

There were no payroll disbursements.
