INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS' REPORT ON APPLYING AGREED-UPON PROCEDURES

Republican Executive Committee Highland County 109 Woodland Drive Hillsboro, Ohio 45133

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, to which the Republican Executive Committee, Highland County, Ohio (the Committee), agreed, solely to assist the Committee in evaluating its compliance with certain requirements included in Ohio Rev. Code Sections 3517.1012, 3517.13(X)(1), 2(b), (3)(a), and (4), 3517.17, and 3517.18, for the year ended December 31, 2006. The Committee is responsible for complying with these requirements. We followed the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants' attestation standards for agreed-upon procedures engagements. The sufficiency of the procedures is solely the responsibility of the Committee. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

Cash Receipts

- 1. We inquired of the Committee whether they deposited all gifts from corporations, labor organizations and all gifts restricted to operations into the same fund into which they deposit amounts received from the State Tax Commissioner. Management informed us they received no such gifts.
- We footed each statement of *Political Party Restricted Fund Deposits*, Ohio Rev. Code Section 3517.17 requires (Deposit Form 31-CC), filed for 2006. We noted no computational errors; however, the Committee did not complete the updated *Statement of Political Party Restricted Fund Deposits* and chose to report moneys received from the Ohio political party fund on the *Statement of Contributions Received* (Form 31-A). Additionally, the Committee did not complete the *Statement of Other Income* (Form 31-A-2) as required by Ohio Rev. Code Section 3517.10 (B), (D) which requires the political party to report interest income, loans, refunds or prior expenditures that are returned to the committee. The Highland County Republican Party reported the refund of a prior year expenditure on the *Statement of Contributions Received* (Form 31-A).
- 3. We compared bank deposits reflected in 2006 restricted fund bank statements to total deposits recorded in Deposit Forms 31-A filed for 2006. We found no exceptions.
- We confirmed amounts received from the State Tax Commissioner pursuant to Ohio Rev. Code 3517.17(A), and agreed them to amounts shown on Deposit Forms 31-A filed for 2006. We found no exceptions.
- 5. We scanned other recorded receipts for evidence that a corporation or labor organization may have exceeded the \$10,000 annual gift limit Ohio Rev. Code 3517(X)(3)(a) imposes. We found no evidence that any corporation or labor organization exceeded this limit.
- 6. Ohio Rev. Code 3517.1012(B) requires the Party to file Forms 31-CC electronically with the Secretary of State when the Committee receives gifts from corporations or labor organizations. The Committee was not required to file electronically.

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Cash Reconciliation

- 1. We recomputed the mathematical accuracy of the December 31, 2006 reconciliation for the bank account used for receipts and disbursements restricted pursuant to Ohio Rev. Code Section 3517.1012(A). We found no computational errors.
- 2. We agreed the bank balance on the reconciliation to the bank statement balance as of December 31, 2006. The balances agreed.
- 3. There were no reconciling items at December 31, 2006.

Cash Disbursements

1. Per review of the Ohio Campaign Finance Report and bank statements, no disbursements were noted in 2006.

We were not engaged to, and did not examine each *Statement of Political Party Restricted Fund Deposits* and *Statement of Political Party Restricted Fund Disbursements* filed for 2006, the objective of which would have been to opine on compliance. Accordingly, we do not express an opinion. Had we performed additional procedures, other matters might have come to our attention that we would have reported to you.
