INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS' REPORT ON APPLYING AGREED-UPON PROCEDURES

Secretary of State of Ohio Democratic Executive Committee Mercer County 605 Royal Lane Celina, Ohio 45822

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, to which the Democratic Party Executive Committee, (the Committee), agreed, solely to assist the Committee in evaluating its compliance with certain requirements included in Ohio Rev. Code Sections 3517.1012, 3517.13(X)(1), 2(b), (3)(a), and (4), 3517.17, and 3517.18, for the year ended December 31, 2007. The Committee is responsible for complying with these requirements. We followed the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants' attestation standards for agreed-upon procedures engagements. The sufficiency of the procedures is solely the responsibility of the Committee. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

Cash Receipts

- We inquired of the Committee whether they deposited all gifts from corporations, labor organizations and all gifts restricted to operations into the same fund into which they deposit amounts received from the State Tax Commissioner. They informed us they received no such gifts.
- 2. We footed each *Statement of Political Party Restricted Fund Deposits* Ohio Rev. Code Section 3517.17 requires (Deposit Form 31-CC), filed for 2007. We noted no computational errors.
- 3. We compared bank deposits reflected in 2007 restricted fund bank statements to total deposits recorded in Deposit Forms 31-CC filed for 2007. The bank deposit amounts agreed to the deposits recorded in the Form.
- 4. We scanned the Committee's 2007 bank statements and noted they reflected four quarterly payments received from the State Tax Commissioner pursuant to Ohio Rev. Code 3517.17(A). We found one exception:

Ohio Rev. Code 3517.17(A) states that each party treasurer receiving public moneys from the Ohio political party fund shall deposit those moneys into the party's restricted fund, and shall expend and maintain those moneys subject to the requirements of that section.

In December of 2007, the Mercer County Democratic Party received \$18.27 of tax check off money and deposited the check into their executive account in error.

The Mercer County Democratic Party Executive Committee transferred the \$18.27 back into the restricted fund account on May 14, 2008.

We scanned other recorded 2007 receipts for evidence that a corporation or labor organization may have exceeded the \$10,000 annual gift limit Ohio Rev. Code 3517.13(X)(3)(a) imposes. We found no evidence that any corporation or labor organization exceeded this limit.

Cash Reconciliation

- 1. We recomputed the mathematical accuracy of the December 31, 2007 reconciliation for the bank account used for receipts and disbursements restricted pursuant to Ohio Rev. Code Section 3517.1012(A). We found no computational errors.
- 2. We agreed the bank balance on the reconciliation to the bank statement balance as of December 31, 2007. The balances agreed.
- We agreed reconciling items appearing on the reconciliation to canceled checks and deposit slips. We determined that the dates and amounts on those documents support that those items were proper reconciling items and were recorded in the proper amount on the reconciliation as of December 31, 2007.

Cash Disbursements

We footed each *Statement of Political Party Restricted Fund Disbursements* Ohio Rev. Code Section 3517.17 requires (Disbursement Form 31-M), filed for 2007. The party made no disbursements. There was a \$17.90 bank charge for purchase of checks which was not recorded on Disbursement Form 31-M.

We were not engaged to, and did not examine each *Statement of Political Party Restricted Fund Deposits* and *Statement of Political Party Restricted Fund Disbursements* filed for 2007, the objective of which would have been to opine on compliance. Accordingly, we do not express an opinion. Had we performed additional procedures, other matters might have come to our attention that we would have reported to you.
