We have audited, in accordance with *Government Auditing Standards* issued by the Comptroller General of the United States, the basic financial statements of the City of Rocky River, Ohio (the City), for the year ended December 31, 2020, and have separately issued our unmodified report thereon dated June 25, 2021.

The City of Rocky River is responsible for the information presented in the Letter. The sufficiency of the procedures is solely the responsibility of the addressees. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

As required by Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-27-15(L)(5)(c) and 3745-27-16-(L)(5)(c), we have agreed the following amounts included in the Letter to the audited financial statements.
