Independent Accountants' Report on Applying Agreed-Upon Procedures

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM), on Mary Beth Rivard's (hereafter referred to as the Provider) compliance with the requirements of the Medicaid Promoting Interoperability Program (MPIP) for the year ended December 31, 2018. The Provider is responsible for compliance with the MPIP requirements. The sufficiency of these procedures is solely the responsibility of ODM. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures enumerated below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

- 1. We did not perform the procedure to confirm that the Provider met the patient volume requirement as the Provider did not submit any supporting documentation.
- 2. We did not compare the system generated dashboard to the applicable criteria and to the summaries for Meaningful Use Objectives and the Clinical Quality Measures as the Provider did not submit any dashboard or other supporting documentation.

Responsible Party's Written Representation

Attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants require that we request a written statement from Ms. Rivard/Equitas Health, Inc. stating that compliance with the Medicaid Provider Incentive Program to which we applied procedures has been accurately evaluated. We requested that Ms. Rivard/Equitas Health, Inc. provide such a statement but Ms. Rivard/Equitas Health, Inc. failed to do so.

This agreed-upon procedures engagement was conducted in accordance with the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants' attestation standards. We were not engaged to and did not conduct an examination or review, the objective of which would be the expression of an opinion or conclusion, respectively, on the Provider's compliance with the requirements of the Medicaid Promoting Interoperability Program. Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion or conclusion. Had we performed additional procedures, other matters might have come to our attention that would have been reported. This report is intended solely for the information and use of the ODM, and is not intended to be, and should not be used by anyone other than the specified party.
