INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS' REPORT ON APPLYING AGREED-UPON PROCEDURES

We have audited, in accordance with *Government Auditing Standards* issued by the Comptroller General of the United States, the basic financial statements of Athens County, Ohio for the year ended December 31, 2021, and have separately issued our unmodified report thereon dated July 26, 2022. These statements do not present a landfill fund, the post-closure liability is included in the General fund and the County's governmental activities.

In a letter to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency dated July 26, 2022 (the Letter), Jill A. The sufficiency of the procedures is solely the responsibility of the parties specified in this report. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

As required by Ohio Administrative Code Sections 3745-27-15(L)(5)(c) and 3745-27-16(L)(5)(c), we have agreed the following amounts included in the Letter to the audited financial statements:

The amounts on line 6 agree to the basic fund financial statements of Athens County, or can be computed from amounts appearing therein. Line 5 includes total assured environmental costs reported in the fund financial statements following Governmental Accounting Statement Number 18.
