# INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS' REPORT ON APPLYING AGREED-UPON PROCEDURES

We have audited, in accordance with *Government Auditing Standards* issued by the Comptroller General of the United States, the basic financial statements of the City of Rocky River, Ohio (the City), for the year ended December 31, 2021, and have separately issued our unmodified report thereon dated July 29, 2022.

In a letter to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency dated July 29, 2022 (the Letter), the Director of Finance of the City of Rocky River specified that certain amounts disclosed in that Letter were derived from the independently audited financial statements referred to in the first paragraph above.

We have performed the procedures described below on the City. The City's management is responsible for the information presented in the Letter.

The City has agreed to and acknowledged that the procedures performed are appropriate to meet the intended purpose of solely providing assistance to you and the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency in determining that certain amounts reported in the Letter agreed to, or can be computed from, amounts presented in the audited basic financial statements. Additionally, the Auditor of State has agreed to and acknowledged that the procedures performed are appropriate to meet their purpose. This report may not be suitable for any other purpose. The procedures performed may not address all the items of interest to a user of this report and may not meet the needs of all users of this report and, as such, users are responsible for determining whether the procedures performed are appropriate for their purposes.

As required by Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-503-05(L)(5)(c), we have agreed the following amounts included in the Letter to the audited financial statements.
