INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANT'S REPORT

We have examined Cloverleaf Local School District, Medina County, Ohio, management's assertion that the census data and pensionable wages reported to the School Employees Retirement System of Ohio as of June 30, 2022, and for the year then ended was accurate and complete.

Management asserts that:

- The census data provided to the School Employees Retirement System of Ohio as of June 30, 2022 is accurate and complete. Census data includes
 - First and Last Name;
 - Last four digits of the social security number;
 - o Gender;
 - Date of Birth;
 - Contributions remitted to the plan;
 - Pensionable Compensation;
- The census data provided to the School Employees Retirement System of Ohio as of June 30, 2022 included all enrolled employees.
- Census data changes occurring during the year ended June 30, 2022 to an enrolled employee's eligible compensation, were properly updated with the School Employees Retirement System of Ohio.
- All employees required to be enrolled in the School Employees Retirement System of Ohio in accordance with statutory requirements were properly enrolled.
- The total pensionable wages and employee contributions information reported to the School Employees Retirement System of Ohio for the year ended June 30, 2022 agrees with the payroll records of the employer.

Cloverleaf Local School District's management is responsible for the assertions. Our responsibility is to opine on management's assertions based on our examination.
